Dear Colleagues:

The new criteria from our national accrediting agency, the Higher Learning Commission (HLC), include a requirement that we systematically be able to show that every instructor (tenure-track, adjunct, etc.) hold adequate "credentials" to teach at the level and course they are teaching. We have to have such a teaching credential validation process in place prior to the upcoming HLC accreditation visit (March 2019). Academic Affairs has kept the Deans apprised of our work to establish such a system over the last year.

At the Deans Council meeting on August 9, 2018 the Office of Faculty Affairs & Services (OFAS) presented the Teaching Credential Validation process for returning adjuncts and new faculty starting fall of 2018.

OFAS has created a webpage that provides you with information regarding the process and access to the on-line form. Once the academic department has completed the form and attached the supporting documentation, it will be submitted to OFAS for review and file.
